

## Watch Parties Guidelines

Thank you for being willing to host a DC Watch Party. Dallas Church is all about “Discovering God’s Dream for Our Lives” as we follow Jesus together. As a church family, we are doing our best under the direction of our leadership to creatively help each other grow in faith while adapting to the constantly changing Covid-19 situation. We believe we can continue to be a church that loves God and loves our neighbor even in the middle of this difficult season.

Our next step forward as a church is a throwback to the church of the New Testament which met together to worship in homes. With the current gathering restrictions and the use of online church platforms we are asking people to open their living room and have church together with the digital service.

As the Host you will set the tone for the Sunday morning worship for people who come to your home. Guidelines for those gatherings.

### From a Discipleship Perspective

- Remember Sunday is about worshipping Jesus not a chance for us to share our personal political opinions.
- Please be kind and understanding of others in all interactions. Some people will be afraid and might wear masks while others might be offended that we can’t meet in a large group gathering like normal. This is an opportunity for us to show love to all who come through our doors.
- As a host, it is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to contact and invite people to your Watch Party. If you need anyone’s number Andrew and Stephanie are more than happy to provide it.
- Use Dallas Church Online content for your Home Church Watch Party.
- Put the Online Service on the TV. Andrew is available for Tech support **prior to Sunday morning** to help you hook up or plug in your device to get the worship service content on your TV.

### From Sanitization Perspective

- Clean and Sanitize all surfaces before and after your Watch Party.
  - Option A- Use Clorox Sanitizing Wipes and have hand sanitizer for everyone as they enter.
  - Option B- Use bleach or other available anti-bacterial cleaner to clean all surfaces and ask everyone to wash their hands in the sink as they arrive.
- Keep 6 feet of separation from all family units.
  - Set your own “max capacity” limit on your living room for maintaining 6 feet.
- If possible, keep the same group of people in your watch party each week.
- Keep your Home Church “Touchless”
  - No Hugs/Handshakes/High-Fives
  - Don’t pass around any Worship Guides, papers, bulletins etc.
  - Use gloves when setting out communion.
